1) Get to know GOD better (Psalm 42:1-2)

- 2) Get to **know God's Word** better (1 Pet. 2:2)
- 3) Get to **know yourself** better (Ps. 139:23-24)

I have endeavored to read thru the entire Bible yearly since 1997, using **Your Daily Walk** devotional. I simply desired to know God and His Word better.

Dr. Gary McIntosh challenged my doctoral cohort to begin a new "ministry" that would regularly benefit people outside of our normal ministry responsibilities. In 2010, I began sending **TODAY'S READ**, a daily text for the **Read thru the Bible in One Year** readings!

2021–2023 saw many people all over the country commit to *The Bible Challenge.* Julie Ferebee suggested a monthly meeting to discuss the readings. *Bible Challenge Review* includes a game & Q/A, Done! Pastor Willie Hicks suggested Ecclesia's Tuesday night 7:14 Devotionals (7:14pm PST) overview each book of the Bible, Done!

Julie Ferebee, Joanne Solomon and Judith Hoston stated *The Bible Challenge* reading schedule was very fast, not allowing much time to process the reading. Thus, in **2022**, *The Bible Challenge* slowed the pace to a *365 Day Journey thru the New Testament!* **Done**!

In **2023 & 2024**, *The Bible Challenge* launched a 2-year Journey. **THE ESSENTIAL OLD TESTAMENT** storylines the OT *without* prophetic insights and **THE PROPHECTIC OLD TESTAMENT** storylines *with* insights of the Major and Minor Prophets. NT readings included the writings of John (Gospel, 1-2-3 John, and Revelation). **Done**!

In **2025**, *The Bible Challenge*, aggressively read THE ENTIRE BIBLE in one year. Reading through the Bible in one year is NOT detailed Bible study. It is simply reading to increase our foundational knowledge of the BIG PICTURE. Start *The Bible Challenge* TODAY!

A Foundation in the Word of God that will LAST a LIFETIME!

### **BIBLE READING SUGGESTIONS**

- **Pick & Stick** Pick a single translation to use for *The Bible Challenge* reading plan. (Using multiple translations, you may miss out on nuances, associations, and other benefits that enhance your understanding by using a single translation.)
- Read Printed Bible preferred to using an electronic Bible.
- Listen to Audio Bible Listening to an audio version of your preferred translation (like *YouVersion* or *Bible Gateway*) and following along in your printed Bible will help you keep a steady pace, enhance retention, minimize distractions, avoid rabbit trails, and help pronounce unfamiliar words. When you run across unfamiliar words, do not skip over them. Take a moment to learn to say them correctly.
- Mark up your Bible Underline, circle, highlight, jot notes and write definitions in margins. Your markups this year will help you retain your current reading and enhance your understanding when you reread those same passages!

Over the years, using colored pens/pencils and several colored highlighters will help to quickly identify the message and movement of a passage. (Refer to *How To Study Your Bible* by Kay Arthur for a good

explanation of a highlighting system.)

- **Check the Box** Check the box each day for each chapter read. This visual check will motivate you to continue.
- **Remember** This is Big Picture READING that includes light STUDY/JOURNAL exercises. **GOALS**: 1) Book readings to get big picture. 2) Establish key word/Prhase to remember each Chapter.
- Make a List While reading, make a list of passages, themes, and key words you would like to study "later."
- **Daily Reading** Prayerfully approach each daily reading as a "**Date**," a consecrated time spent with God. You desire to know God better and to receive new understanding. Avoid letting familiarity with a passage hinder your growth.
