An Authentic Life! An Authentic Discipleship 1 Thessalonians 3:1-13 NKJV Dr. Joshua Beckley, Senior Pastor

## INTRODUCTION

Paul, Silas, and Timothy brought the gospel to Thessalonica.

- Believers in Thessalonica accepted the message.
- Paul longs to be with them again.

Paul again sends Timothy to encourage them in their Christian faith.

- Paul earlier received positive reports from Timothy.
- Paul prays for even greater growth in Christ among the Thessalonians.

Paul's posture - discipleship is about authentic relationship that motivated the desire to grow.

One key to Authentic Discipleship is Surrender on both sides:

- One side the Discipler
- Other side the Disciplee

Paul models three components of Discipleship that we need recognize and display.

### **AUTHENTIC DISCIPLESHIP IS:**

1) CONCERNED ABOUT SPIRITUAL - 1 Thess. 3:1-5 NKJV

Even the best technology is no replacement for relationship. Paul sent Timothy!

### Authentic Discipleship in its CONCERN for Spiritual Maturity seeks to:

- a) Stabilize Faith 1 Thessalonians 3:2 Encourage (Greek, *parakaleo*)
- b) Shake Fear 1 Thessalonians 3:3

Dr. Tony Evans Believer are appointed to trouble. We are elected, chosen, destined, for trouble. It knows our address, and it will arrive at our door, according to John 16:33. But the good news is that God intends to use it for good.

c) Stop Satan - 1 Thessalonians 3:5

 Paul knew that the devil is an evil spirit who hates God and seeks to tempt God's children and destroy their faith.

# 2) CONSISTENT IN SPIRITUAL - 1 Thess. 3:6-10 NKJV

## Authentic Discipleship, being CONSISTENT in Spiritual Mentoring, seeks to:

a) Energize Faith - 1 Thessalonians 3:7

Dr. Tony Evans Everyone loses faith. Everyone falls down. We need someone to pick us up again. Paul had the Thessalonians. Whom do you have? Connectivity with a solid, biblically centered local church is indispensable for properly progressing in the Christian life.

b) Encourage Perseverance - 1 Thessalonians 3:8

- How you stand will determine how we live!

- c) Endorse Fellowship 1 Thessalonians 3:10
  - Faith needs community!

*On our own, our faith is lacking. If we believe all by ourselves, we will not believe for long. Any unchurched, uninvolved Christian is living outside the will of God.* 

## 3) CONFIDENT IN SPIRITUAL - 1 Thess. 3:11-32 NKJV

### Authentic Discipleship, being CONFIDENT in Spiritual Mentoring, seeks to model:

a) Submission to the Father - 1 Thessalonians 3:11

"Direct" (Greek: *kateuthyno*) - means to guide, to lead, to make straight.

b) Sincerity to one another - 1 Thessalonians 3:12

-Love is a choice to serve someone for his or her good!

c) Sanctity in Motives - 1 Thessalonians 3:13

"Heart" (Greek: kardio), English word "cardio" means the inner self or mind.
