## INTRODUCTION

1 Thessalonians 4 begins the central thrust of Paul's message. Continue to please God in daily lives:

- Avoid sexual sin
- Love one another
- Live as good citizens in a secular world
- Encourage them to WALK WITH INTEGRITY

**Integrity** - wholeness; uprightness; honesty or soundness of moral principle and character, an undivided or unbroken completeness or totality with nothing wanting.

## Our witness, even in the everyday events of our lives, makes a difference in others' lives!

## AN AUTHENTIC WALK:

1) CONSCIOUSLY COMMITS TO \_\_\_\_\_\_ GOD - 1 Thessalonians 4:1-2 NKJV

An Authentic walk is consciously committed to please God.

- Simply one step: Obey God's Word!
- Romans 1:19-20 NKJV

## 2) CONCENTRATES ON \_\_\_\_\_\_ - 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8 NKJV

When a person becomes a Christian, he usually undergoes some radical life changes, especially if he has had an immoral background.

- First steps of spiritual growth and self-denial gets rid of the large, obvious sins.
- But sad to say, many believers stop there.
- They don't go on to eliminate the little sins that clutter the landscape of their lives.

"Sanctification" (Greek, hagiasmos) - means holiness, consecration, dedicated to God.

"Abstain" (Greek, apecho) - means to stay away from, to distance ourselves from it.

Abstain or distance ourselves from one main thing that affects everything in our lives.

## 3) CONSISTENTLY DISPLAYS COMPASSIONATE \_\_\_\_\_\_ - 1 Thessalonians 4:9-12 NKJV

Charles Haddon Spurgeon about Integrity:

Nothing reflects so much honor on a workman as a trial of his work and its endurance of it. So it is with God. It honors Him when His saints preserve their integrity.

## Integrity motivated by the Love of God for each other!

- Paul not concerned, because it was what they were doing.
- But Paul urged them to "Increase..."

## Goals for Increase:

- Practice Co-operation (live quietly) ..... (lead a quiet life)
- **Pay Attention to What Yours** ...... (mind your business)
- **Provide For Your Needs** ...... (work with your hands)
- **Promote Integrity in the Secular World** ..... (walk properly toward those outside)
- **Produce Provision for Yourself** ...... (that you may lack nothing!)
