## "A Declaration to Possess the Promises!"

Sermon Text: Joshua 24:1-28 NLT Dr. Joshua Beckley, Senior Pastor

## INTRODUCTION

The officials at this gathering were the same as in Chapter 23

-the elders, leaders, judges, and officials (23:2)

-but this time the entire nation is also mentioned as being present

"... all the people," 24:1)

They all presented themselves "before God," which was undoubtedly before the ark.

Joshua gathered the Israelites at Shechem:

- new location for their national gatherings
- most recently the setting appears to have been at Shiloh: (18:1)

This is the first time this important city is mentioned in Joshua (except in the land distribution lists), although the covenant renewal ceremony in Joshua 8:30–35 took place at Mount Ebal, near Shechem.

- It was at Shechem that God first promised to give Abraham the land (Gen 12:6–7),
- Now, centuries later, God's promises finally had come true
- The covenant was renewed in the very place where he had made them.

God had given His declaration to Abraham some 450 years before. **Now** what He declared had come true.

#### 1) WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO OR MAKE A DECLARATION

- A. God Tells us to Declare
  - † Exodus 9:16 NKJV
  - + Leviticus 23:44 NKJV
  - † Deuteronomy 4:14 NKJV
- B. To Declare (Hebrew: neged) means before.
  - Root basically denotes "to place a matter high, conspicuous before a person."
  - Conspicuous (def) Standing out; to be clearly visable
  - The arabic nagada means "be conspicuous."
  - Usually the "matter" was previously unknown or unknowable to the object.
  - The meaning is further enlightened by considering the following synonomous parallels: 'āmar "to say" and šāma " 'to make known."
- C. To Declare means say something in a solemn and emphatic manner.
- D. A Declaration means a formal or explicit statement or announcement: the formal announcement of the beginning of a state or condition.
